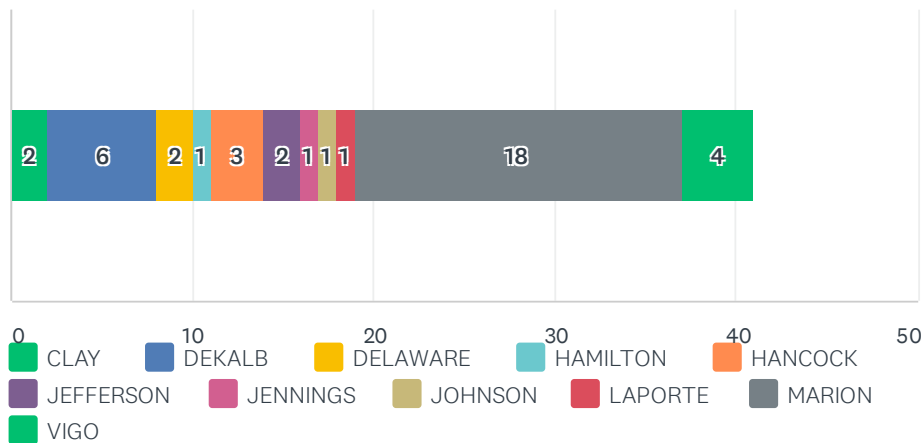


## Q1 Counties trained on Breathe Curriculum as of June 28, 2021:

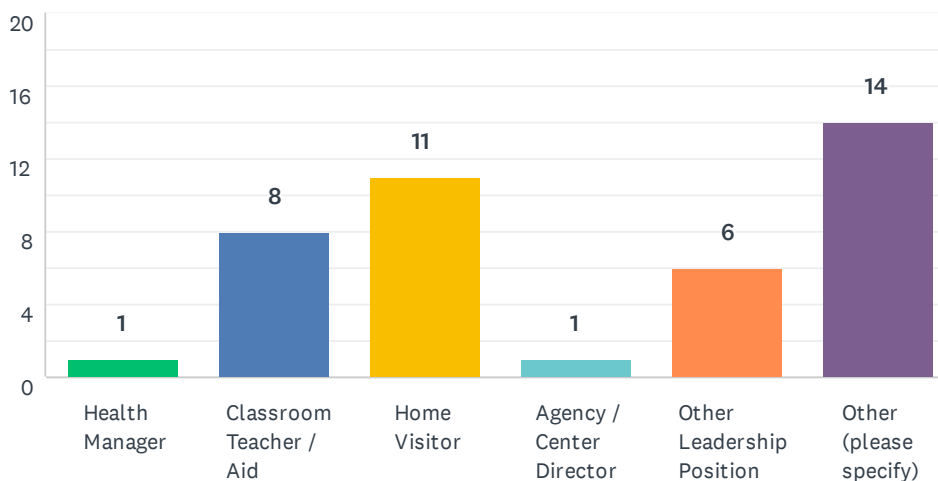

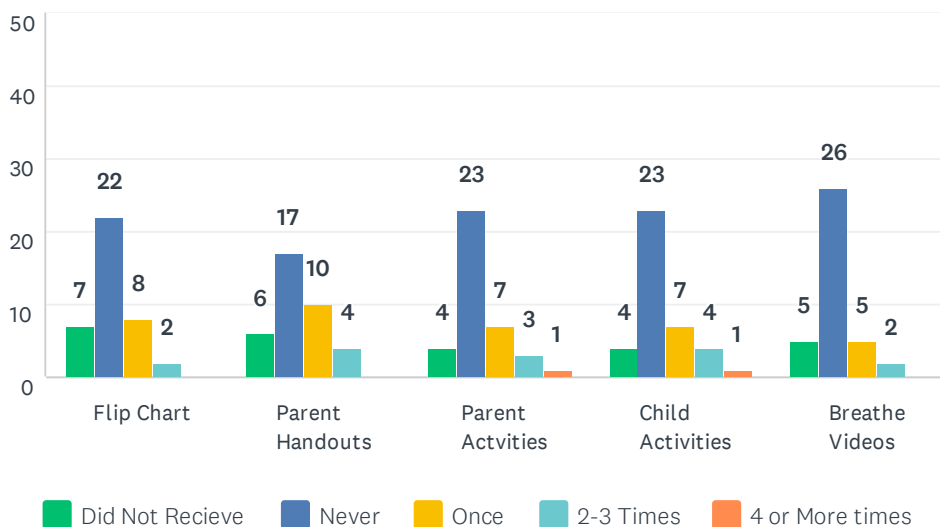

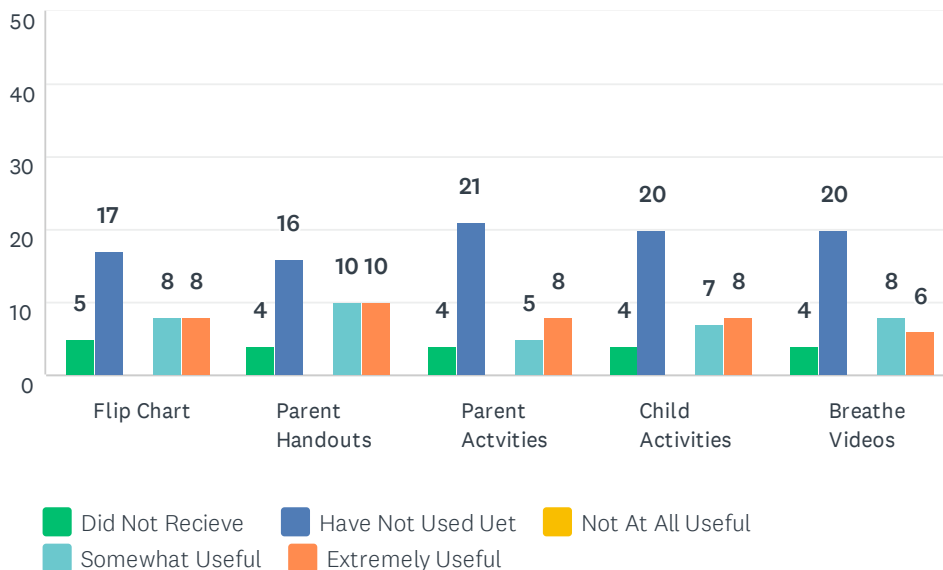

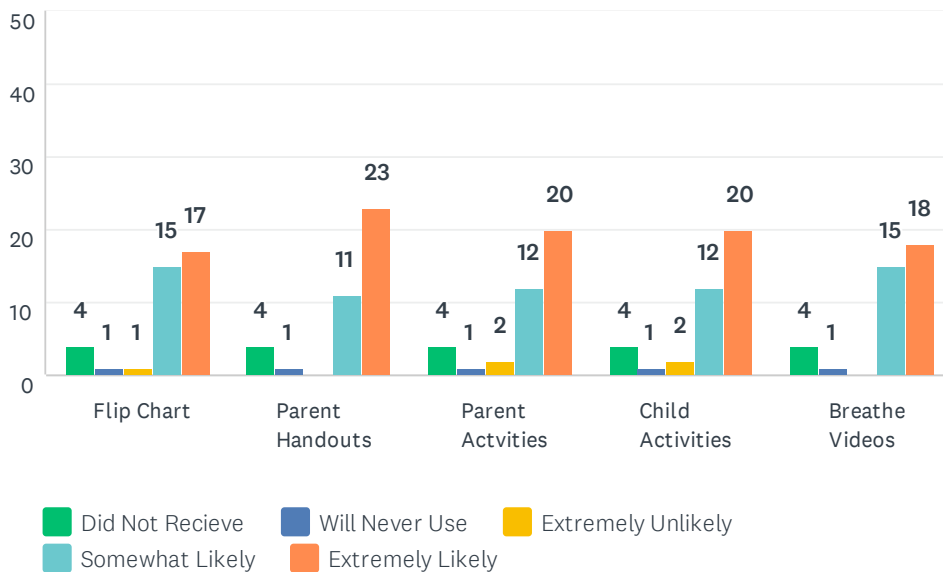
