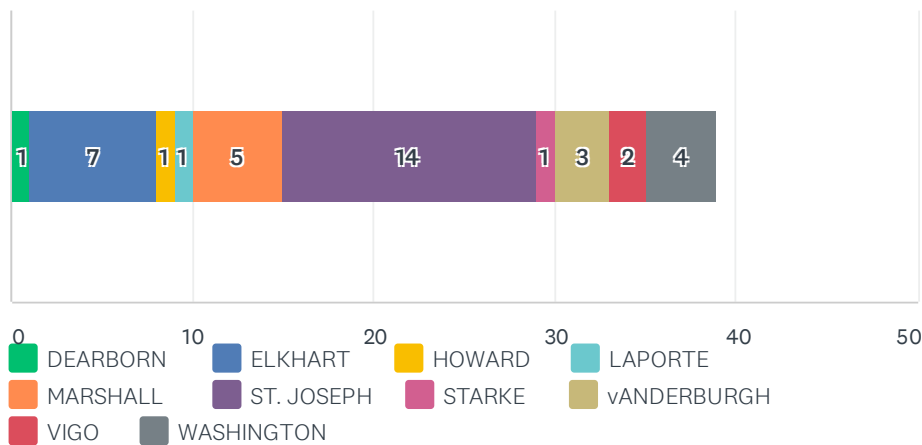


Q1 Counties trained 2nd year of grant cycle (July 1, 2020- June 30, 2021) on Breathe Curriculum:

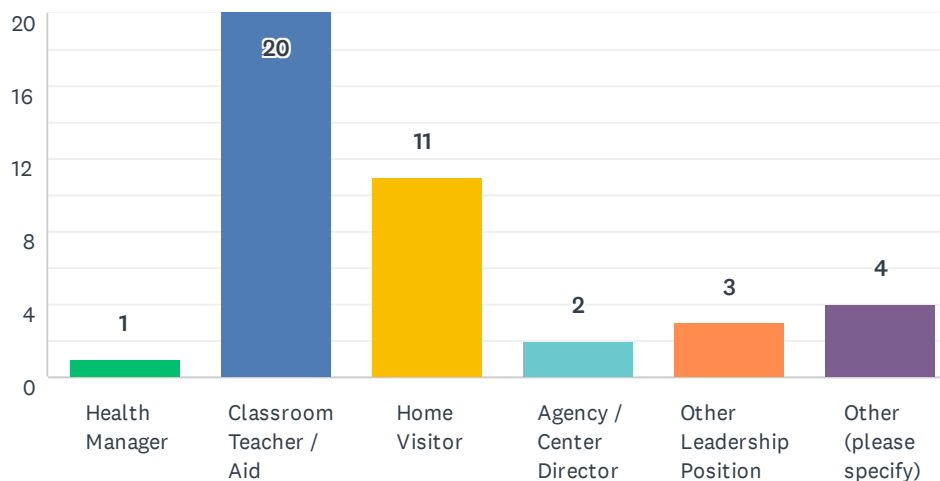

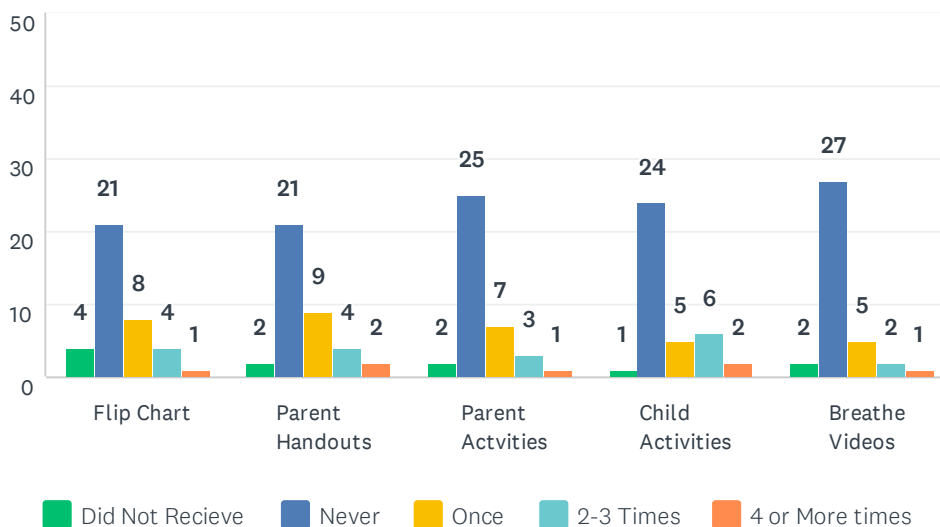

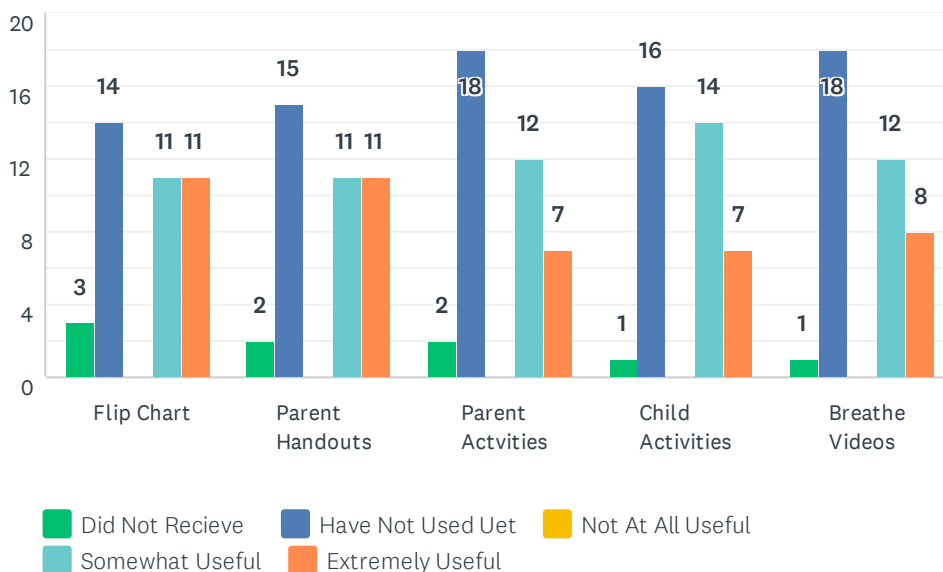

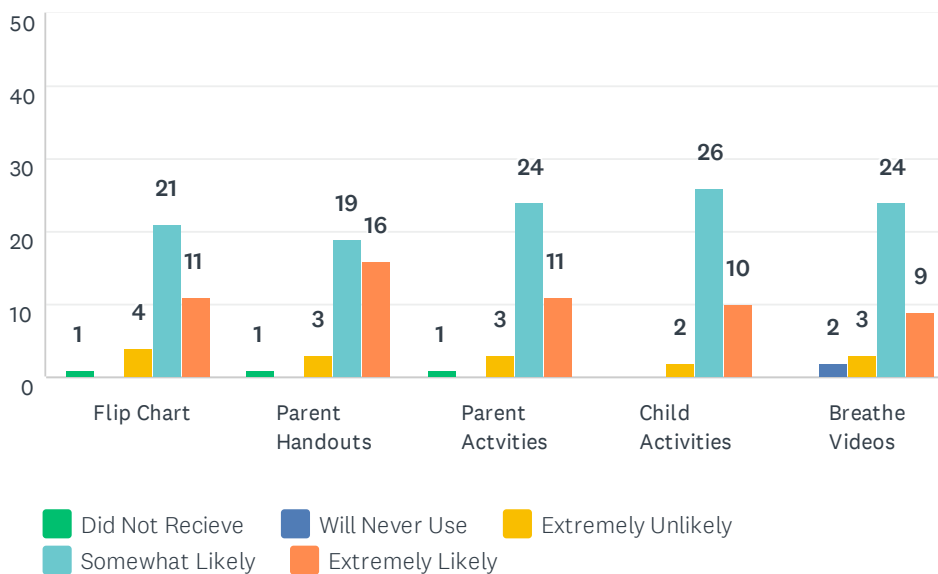
