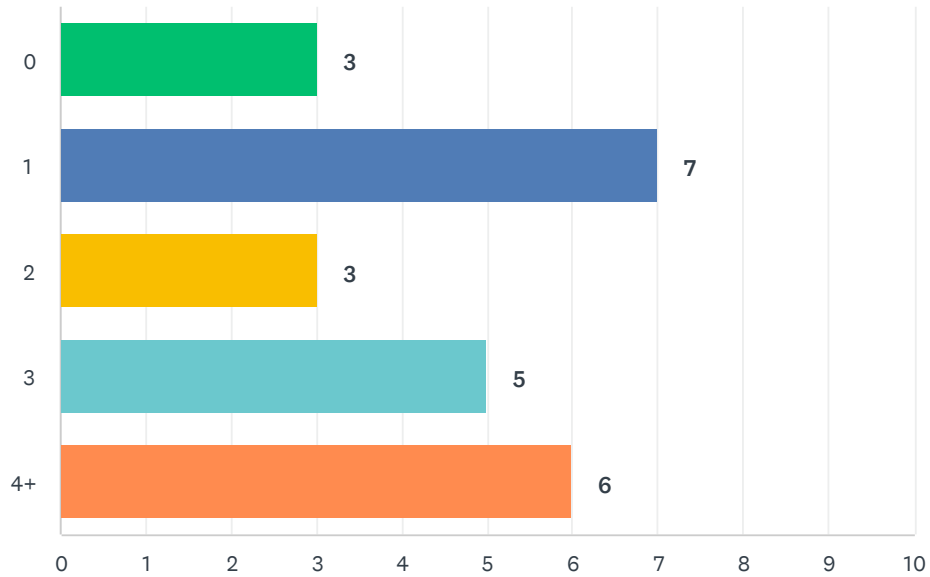


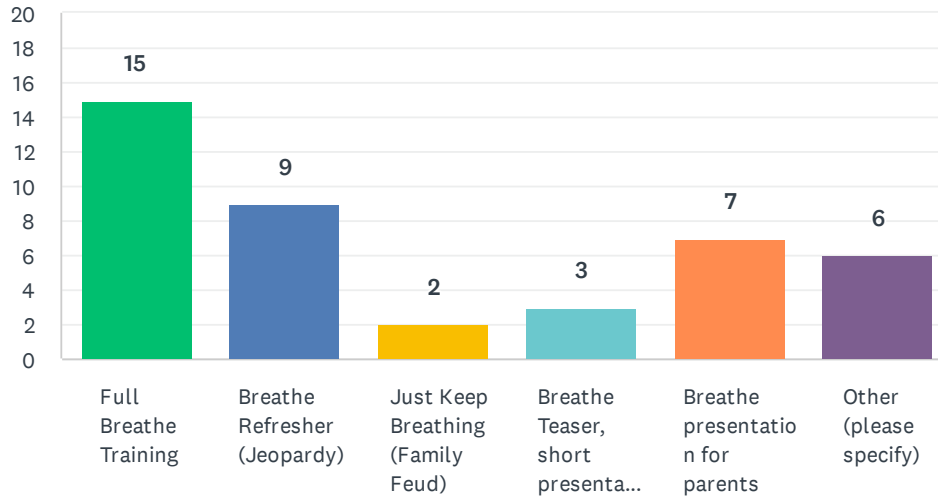
Q2 How many in-person or virtual Breathe Trainings or Breathe Refreshers have you conducted during this grant cycle (July 2021-June 2023)?

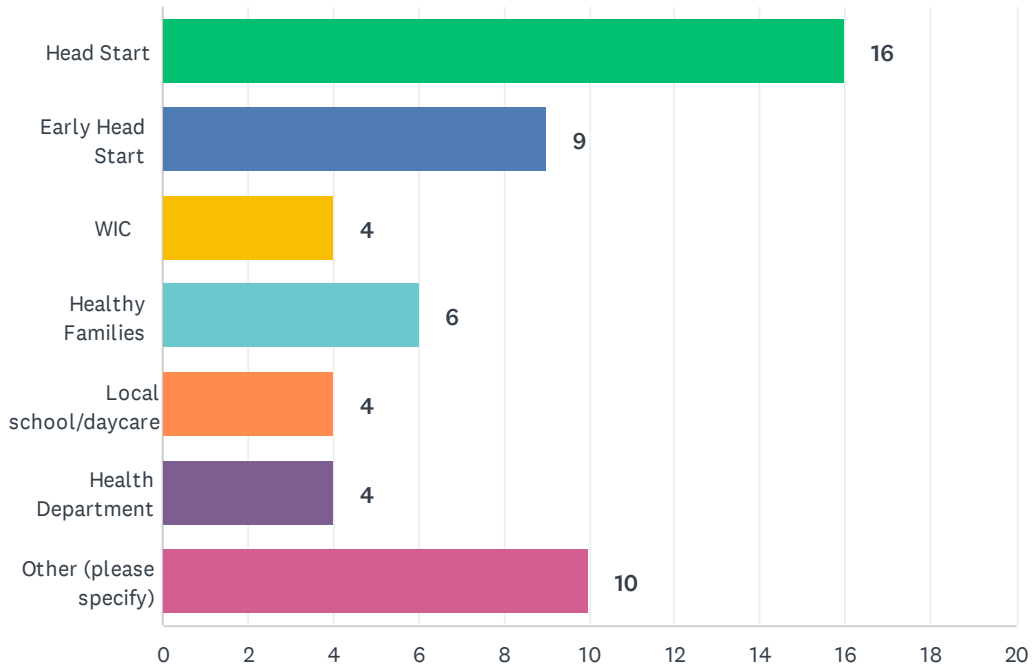

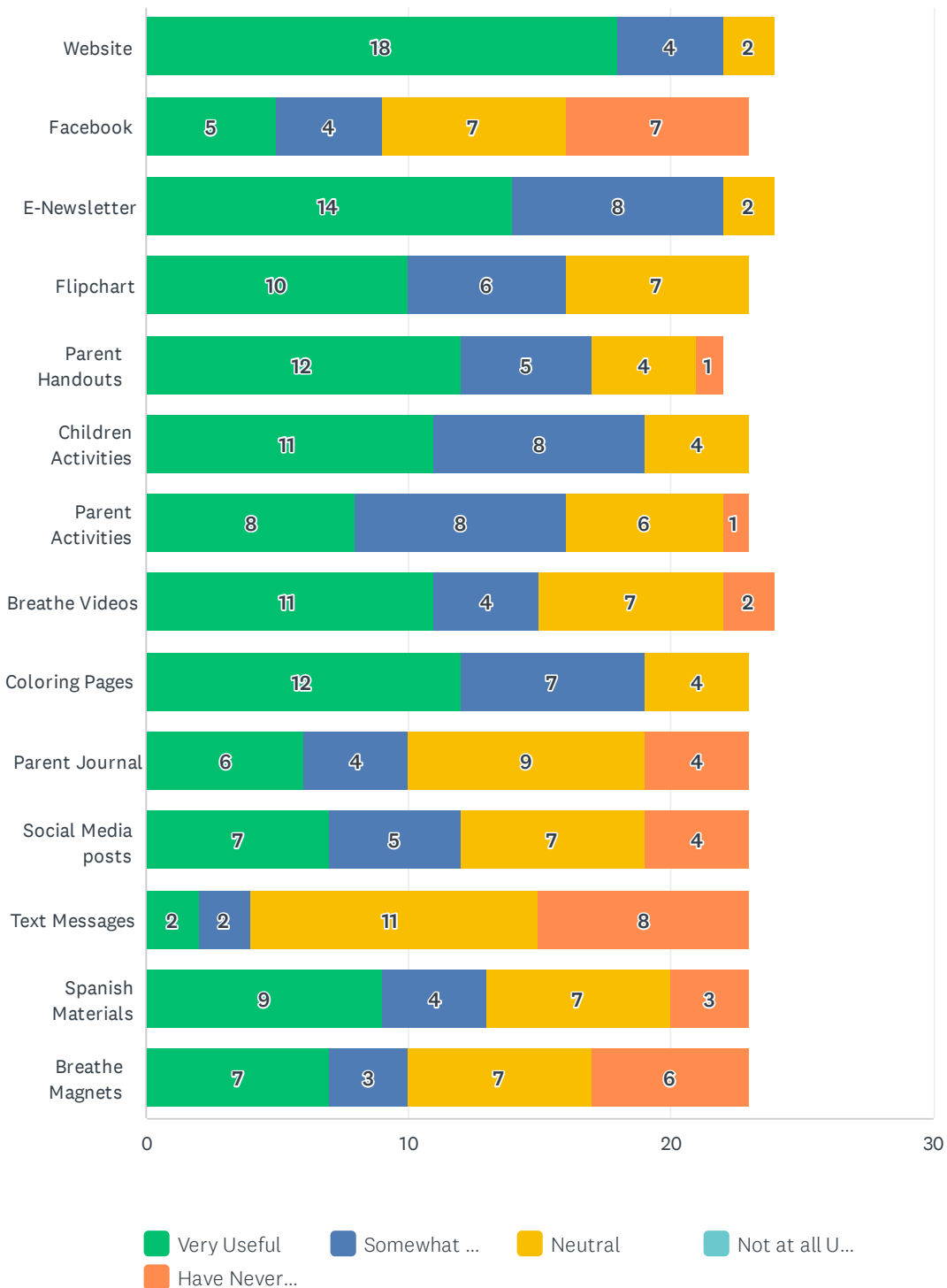

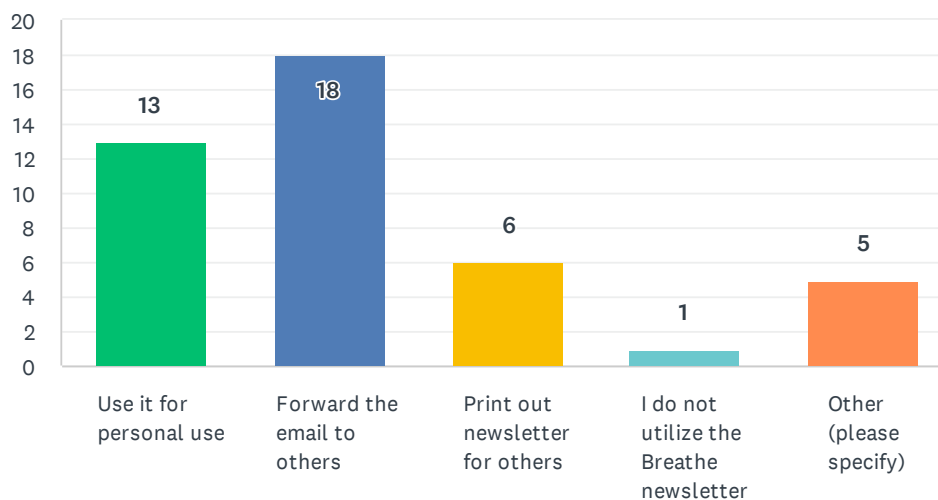
